APPALACHIAN FESTIVAL

Batavia, OH- The Clermont County Public Library (CCPL), Felicity Branch Library will host its popular Appalachian Festival on Saturday, October 27, 2007 from 2:00-4:00 pm. The Felicity Branch Library is located at 209 Prather Road.

Celebrating its third year, the Appalachian Festival will feature a Squire Boone presentation by Nancy and Michael Rumping of Bethel, Ohio. The Rumpings have been reenacting the 18th century for over thirty years and have been doing first-person living history presentations for about seven years through their company, 'Living History Productions'. They recently finished filming Simon Kenton's story at the historic Acord Cabin in Burke Park located in Bethel, Ohio. Douglas Jones owner of "That's Just Muggs Productions" produced the soon-to-be-released video.

Felicity Branch Library's *Cardinal Quilters* will demonstrate their quilting techniques as well as their latest project – a quilt depicting different scenes and landmarks in Felicity. CCPL employee Beth Eicher will also demonstrate the art of spinning.

There will be appearances by the Lawson Family Old Tyme Music and storytelling by CCPL's own Dreamweavers storytelling troupe. Traditional Appalachian fare - beans, cornbread and sweet tea will be served throughout the day.
