Women's Pro Tour 'Tees Up' to Support Reading

BATAVIA, OH- (JUNE 1)--Four members of the Duramed Futures golf tour will visit the Anderson and Blue Ash branches of the Public Library of Cincinnati and Hamilton County and the Union Township branch of the Clermont County Public Library Wednesday afternoon, June 20. The players, in Cincinnati to compete in the first-ever Duramed Championship, will talk about life on the women's professional golf tour and also offer golf tips.

"I am excited about having the golfers come to Union Township", says Lisa Salyers, manager of the Union Township Branch Library. "The collaboration with the Public Library of Cincinnati and Hamilton County is a wonderful opportunity, and I'm glad Union Township gets to be a part of it.

The inaugural Duramed Championship will be played at the Golf Club at Stonelick Hills, Batavia, on June 22-24. The event carries a \$100,000 purse, one of the top purses on the tour, which serves as the "road to the LPGA" for women golfers. The local event benefits the First Tee youth golf program of Greater Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky.

Players Dana Lacey, Courtney Clark, Kelly Lagedrost and Heather Zielinski will visit the Anderson branch, 7450 State Road, from 2:00-3:00 p.m. on June 20th, then be at the Blue Ash branch, 4911 Cooper Road, from 3:30-4:30 p.m. They'll finish the day at the Union Township branch in Clermont County, 4462 Mt. Carmel-Tobasco Road, from 5:30-6:30 p.m. Putters will be provided, or you can bring your own. Door prizes will be awarded, and youth (ages 6 to 18) can register for a chance to be featured in a READ poster with one of the Duramed Futures Tour pros.
