GRAMMY-NOMINATED RECORDING ARTIST
TO VISIT LIBRARY

Batavia, OH - Grammy-nominated recording artist Zak Morgan will delight children and parents alike with his wonderful wordplay and magical live performance at the Union Township Branch Library on Saturday, November 17, 2007 at 10:30 am. His love of reading and imagining and his motto, "I can do it" are contagious.

In his high energy and interactive live performances, Morgan uses music, magic, theatre, and comedy as vehicles to encourage children to read books and use their imaginations.

Zak's physical comedy is reminiscent of a young Steve Martin, and his writing is frequently characterized as a cross between Dr. Seuss and Shel Silverstein because of the fun he has with language. His trademark wit and wordplay permeate his music.

Morgan's 1999 debut album, *Bloom*, was met nationally with rave reviews and awards, and his second CD, *When Bullfrogs Croak*, was nominated for a 2004 GRAMMY, a rare feat for an independent release. Morgan lives in Los Angeles and just finished a world-class DVD/television pilot called ZakLand.
