LIBRARY BOARD APPOINTS MEZACK DIRECTOR

Batavia, OH – The Clermont County Public Library (CCPL) Board of Trustees voted unanimously during the July 14<sup>th</sup> board meeting to appoint David Mezack as the Executive Director of the library.

Prior to this appointment, Mr. Mezack served as the Interim Director for the library since October 2007. In addition to fulfilling the role of Interim Director, he also served as Operations Coordinator and will continue to do so as Executive Director.

During his twelve year – tenure with CCPL, Mr. Mezack oversaw the construction of the Milford-Miami Township, Owensville, New Richmond and Bethel Branch facilities. He also coordinated the installation of the fire security systems and streamlined the technology department, oversaw the development of a disaster recovery plan, and is in charge of public and staff safety.

Mr. Mezack’s appointment came after months of careful review and consideration of all the candidates. “Mr. Mezack’s background and experience in our library system make him uniquely qualified to fill this role,” said Library Board President Joseph Braun. “He has proven his ability to use his management skills to oversee the operation of what I believe is a first class library system made up of a great team of library professionals.”

“Dave jumped into the role of Interim Director and tackled issues such as staffing shortages, human resources policy and salary administration,” said Library Board Vice President Anthony Cardinal. “The way he handled these issues effectively and efficiently impressed the Library Board. The results have been outstanding. He performed very well in the role of Interim Director.”
