

How did we **INFORM, ENGAGE** and **INSPIRE** our public in 2016?



EARLY LITERACY

Our staff members presented 808 storytimes sharing the five practices of Early Literacy with an attendance of 15,520 children and their caregivers.



STAKEHOLDERS

A total of 573,851 library visits resulted in 1,361,287 items being checked out and 7,692 library cards and eCards being issued.



COMMUNITY VISITS

Staff visited 1,200 preschools, daycares, schools and retirement communities with 54,600 in attendance.



LIFELONG LEARNING

In addition to Early Literacy, all 10 branches presented an additional 2,222 classes, discussions, lectures and demonstrations with 33,907 in attendance.



DIGITAL

Our website had 423,868 visitors downloading, streaming and exploring our digital resources. Users logged 619,254 sessions using the public computers and our Wi-Fi. The eResources (databases) were accessed 1,711,659 times.



INFORMAL ENGAGEMENT

The libraries had 16,104 involved in informal engagement sessions, including meeting room use, homework center and passive programs.
